


Walmart and Sam's Club associates can volunteer and give to organizations they care about through the Spark Good associate platform.

3 steps to get started with Spark Good




Create a **Spark Good account** at Walmart.com/nonprofits

Click "Access Spark Good"

Select your entity type.


- Public Charity (501c3) e.g. NWA Food Bank
- NCES School Public, private schools with a NCES ID.
- Government Entity (non 501c3) State, count or city agency (e.g. Sheriff Dept, Fire Dept)
- Other Nonprofits Non-charitable such as civic orgs or local associations listed on the IRS Business List (501c6, 50c9, etc.)
- Other Local Group Community groups not on the IRS Business List.





Sign in or create your **Walmart.com account.**

*Make sure you log in using your organizational email address.



Click "Add Organization"

It will take you to Deed to claim your organization.

Claim your profile.

The person claiming your organization's account should have access to your PayPal Business Account/PayPal Charity Fund credentials.

Round Up Overview




Round Up is a year-round program available on Walmart.com

Important: Organizations must register for the program before customers can discover your organization.

Round Up provides customers shopping on **Walmart.com or in the app** the opportunity to select a charity of their choice to support at checkout on Walmart.com and the app. **The programs is <u>NOT available</u> in stores.**

Organizations must be 501(c)(3) public charities or NCES school and Deed verified to apply for the Round Up program.



Key Takeaways



Only primary user can register for Round Up.



Make sure your electronic bank details is entered in Network for Good



Your organization is only discoverable to customers after you have signed up.


To sign up for Round Up or to ensure you are eligible to continue receiving disbursements, please enter your electronic payment details with Network for Good, After your payment is successfully set up, return here to complete the next steps for enrollment.

To start your registration, you will be required to set up your electronic bank information with Network for Good.

Click "Manage Payment Settings"

It can take several weeks to set up your payment. Email eftsupport@networkforgood.org if you have issues setting up payment. After your payment is successfully set up, please wait 24 hours for your data to sync from Network for Good to Walmart.




After receiving confirmation from Network of Good, return to your Spark Good account. Click ""Get Started". Create your donor-facing profile page


Ways customer can select your organization

Option 1: Visit Walmart.com/sparkgood




- Type in your organization name
- Input or clear the zip code to search
- Option: Filter by type
- You can see if a charity has registry or Round up by the labels.
- You will see the charity appear in a pop up on the right.

Option 2: From their Walmart.com Account Settings



Option 3: Share your Org Profile Page




- An organization can share a direct link to their public profile page.
- A customer can visit that page and click "Select this charity" or "Update my preferred charity" if they already have a previous selection.

NOTE: The round up option <u>only appears</u> in a customer's review order cart after they have selected an organization & added a default payment method of credit/debit.




How to track customer donations



Option 1

Organization profile page: Walmart.com shows the count of unique customers donations and is updated when a customer is charged for their donation.



Option 2

Nonprofit dashboard: Walmart.com/nonprofits displays the dollar amount donated by customers and is updated quarterly after payment is disbursed by Network for Good.

Onboarding Checklist

Checklist on how to get started with Walmart Spark Good Programs

This checklist is applicable for 501c3 Public Charities, NCES Schools, Government Entities and Other Nonprofits

Scenario: You are an organization that is ready to engage with Walmart Spark Good giving programs for the first time!

Step 1: Set up your Spark Good Portal Account

- Start at Walmart.com/nonprofits, Click "Access Spark Good" and select your entity type.
- Create your Walmart.com account.
- Use an email assigned by the organization instead of your personal email.
- . Note: This same email address needs to match when you set up your Deed account in Step 3.

Step 2: Connect your organization to your Walmart Spark Good Portal Account

- To connect your organization to your portal account from the organization list page (lobby), click "Add organization" to claim your profile and complete your verification with Deed who authenticates your organization and users.
- If you have multiple locations, you will be able to create chapter accounts. Read here to learn

How do I know if I've completed all the steps?

- Click through every Deed pop-up and provide all the information needed in each pop-up Under "Settings," check the "Payments" tab and make sure that PayPal/Network for Good is setup.
- Under "Companies", check that your organization is affiliated with Walmart. Review users in Deed under Settings > Users to make sure that they have appropriate access to
- - Owner | Admin → Primary Users in Spark Good
 - Organizers and Ambassadors → Secondary Users in Spark Good

Step 4. Return to Walmart Spark Good Account

Click "In Partnership with Walmart" logo at the top of the screen to return to Walmart Spark Good Portal account to start engaging with Spark Good programs.

Step 5: Engage with Spark Good programs on your Spark Good Account


